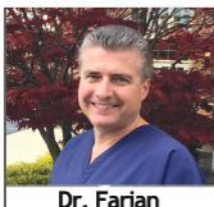

Bonding/ Veneers for Special Events

Dental bonding is a popular treatment that uses composite resin (the same strong material used in tooth-colored fillings) to sculpt a new surface over a tooth and give it a new shape, color, or texture.

When the correction looks perfect, we apply a curing light to permanently harden and bond the material to the tooth. Bonding is a great choice when you have a couple of gaps you would like to fill, or have one or two teeth that stand out and detract from your smile. The best part? Bonding is fast and affordable, and can be completed in a single visit.

If you are interested in acquiring a brand-new smile of your own design, porcelain veneers deliver stunning results! Veneers are super-thin shells of dental ceramic—some only as thin as a contact lens—that affix to the front of each tooth to create a new appearance.

Natural looking veneers let you choose every aspect of your new smile's appearance, including the color, size, shape, and translucence of each tooth. Veneers are also a great choice if you have sensitive teeth with eroded enamel, as they form a sturdy barrier that protects your teeth from further structural damage.
